Steven V. Roberts is the author of *My Fathers' Houses* and coauthor (with Cokie Roberts) of the *New York Times* bestseller *From This Day Forward*. He has worked as a journalist for more than forty years, including positions at the *New York Times*, where he was bureau chief in Los Angeles and Athens, and a Congressional and White House correspondent, and at *U.S. News & World Report*. Roberts and his wife, television journalist and author Cokie Roberts, write a popular nationally syndicated newspaper column. He is a contributing writer for *USA Weekend*. A well-known commentator on many Washington-based television shows, Roberts appears regularly as a political analyst on the ABC radio network and National Public Radio. Since 1997, he has been the Shapiro Professor of Media and Public Affairs at George Washington University. A father of two and grandfather of six, he lives with his wife, Cokie, in Bethesda, Maryland.
